

To reduce the impact of COVID-19 outbreak conditions on businesses, workers, customers, and the public, we have updated our inspection guidelines for all present during the on-site inspection. This includes but not limited to the inspector and contact present for the inspection. Please review before accepting or proceeding with an inspection.

- 1. All inspectors must adhere to their shelter in place or stay at home orders as issued by your county, city and/or state. Please check your local guidelines prior to proceeding with an on-site inspection.
- 2. If you are sick or have COVID symptoms do not proceed with an on-site inspection even if it has already been scheduled. Please contact our office immediately to reschedule the appointment.
- 3. The inspector must bring and wear personal protective equipment (PPE). A face covering is required while performing any on-site inspection.
- 4. Maintain a minimum of six-foot distance from one another during the on-site inspection.
- 5. Do not shake hands or engage in any unnecessary physical contact.
- 6. Frequently wash hands for a least 20 seconds with soap and water or use hand sanitizer.

By accepting this inspection, you agree that:

- 1. You are NOT currently sick or have any COVID symptoms.
- 2. You have NOT had close contact (within 6 feet/2 meters for than 15 minutes) with anyone who is either confirmed or suspected of having COVID-19, in the last 14 days, including anyone who is experiencing or displaying any of the known symptoms of COVID-19.
- 3. You have NOT tested positive or have been tested and are awaiting the results for COVID-19 in the last 14 days.

If you cannot agree that all the above statements are true, you may NOT accept the on-site inspection order.
